## Environmental Mitigation Measures

The design and construction of the Anderson Road Quarry Site Development Project meets all relevant environmental protection requirements and adopts various feasible measures to reduce the impact of the Project to the public and the environment. At the same time, the Civil Engineering and Development Department commissioned an independent environmental consultant to make an environmental impact monitoring report. During the construction period, the engineering team will implement the corresponding mitigation measures according to the report's recommendations and actual needs (such as the weather conditions at the time).

The mitigation measures commonly used in the Project mainly deal with construction noise, dust and water quality. The project adopts low-noise motorized equipment, constructs noise barriers, covers mechanical equipment with acoustic materials to effectively reduce construction noise. In addition, construction noise is monitored regularly with equipment. In order to maintain the good air quality of nearby dwellings, we use gauze to cover soil, place mist cannons in the site, arrange mist sprayers to sprinkle water regularly, set up wheel washing facilities at the entrances and exits of the sites to prevent the vehicles from taking dust off the construction site. Moreover, we often conduct site patrol to collect water samples, remove stagnant water and rubbish regularly, spray mosquito oil when necessary, and hold anti-mosquito lectures to educate site staff to prevent mosquito problems.

- Mist cannon is placed in the site
- Equipment is wrapped by acoustic materials
- Water samples are collected regularly
- Spray mosquito oil when necessary
- Clean up rubbish in the site regularly
- Monitor construction noise with equipment
